Student Code of Conduct

RESPECT FOR SCHOOL

1. Sing the School Song with pride.
2. Wear the prescribed School uniform.
3. Not make any modifications to my School uniform.

RESPECT FOR SELF – PERSONAL GROOMING

1. Uphold high standards of personal grooming and hygiene by adhering to the following:
 - Hair not to be tinted nor dyed.
 - Girls – Hair beyond shoulder-length to be tied up. Face to be free of any form of make-up and neat in appearance.
 - Boys – Hair to be kept short. Face to be clean-shaven and neat in appearance.
 - No accessory for aesthetic or religious reasons to be worn. (Girls may wear a pair of simple ear studs at the ear lobes)
 - Tattoo and all other forms of body piercing not allowed.
 - Nails to be kept short, clean and free of nail varnish.
 - Contact lenses to be transparent (without colour).

Wearing the School Uniform

- Enhance individual image
- Instill personal discipline in preparation for work and life

Spectra Originals

- Worn on Friday Specials or when instructed by Year Heads
- To be worn with uniform pants/ culottes and shorts

Official (Closed) / Sensitive (Normal)

CCA Attire

- To be worn only during or just before and after CCA sessions
- Attire as required by respective CCAs



Socks

- Plain white or black socks only
- Socks covering ankle bone but below the calf muscle



Shoes

- Canvas shoes: Plain white or black with similar coloured laces
- Running shoes: Any colour
- Shoes should reveal ankle



Accessories

- No accessory for aesthetic or religious reasons to be worn (Girls may wear a pair of simple ear studs at the ear lobes)

Allowed for girls only



- Contact lenses to be transparent (without colour).

Hair

- Shall be of natural colour (similar as the root)
- Fringe should not touch the eyebrow, collar or ears
- Girls with hair beyond shoulder-length to be neatly tied up or pinned up
- Boys' faces should be clean shaven
- Boys should maintain sideburns at eye level or above.



Reminder

Remove the following upon entering School:

1. Outerwear (e.g. jackets, cardigans, sweaters)
2. Listening devices (e.g. headphones, earphones, earbuds)
